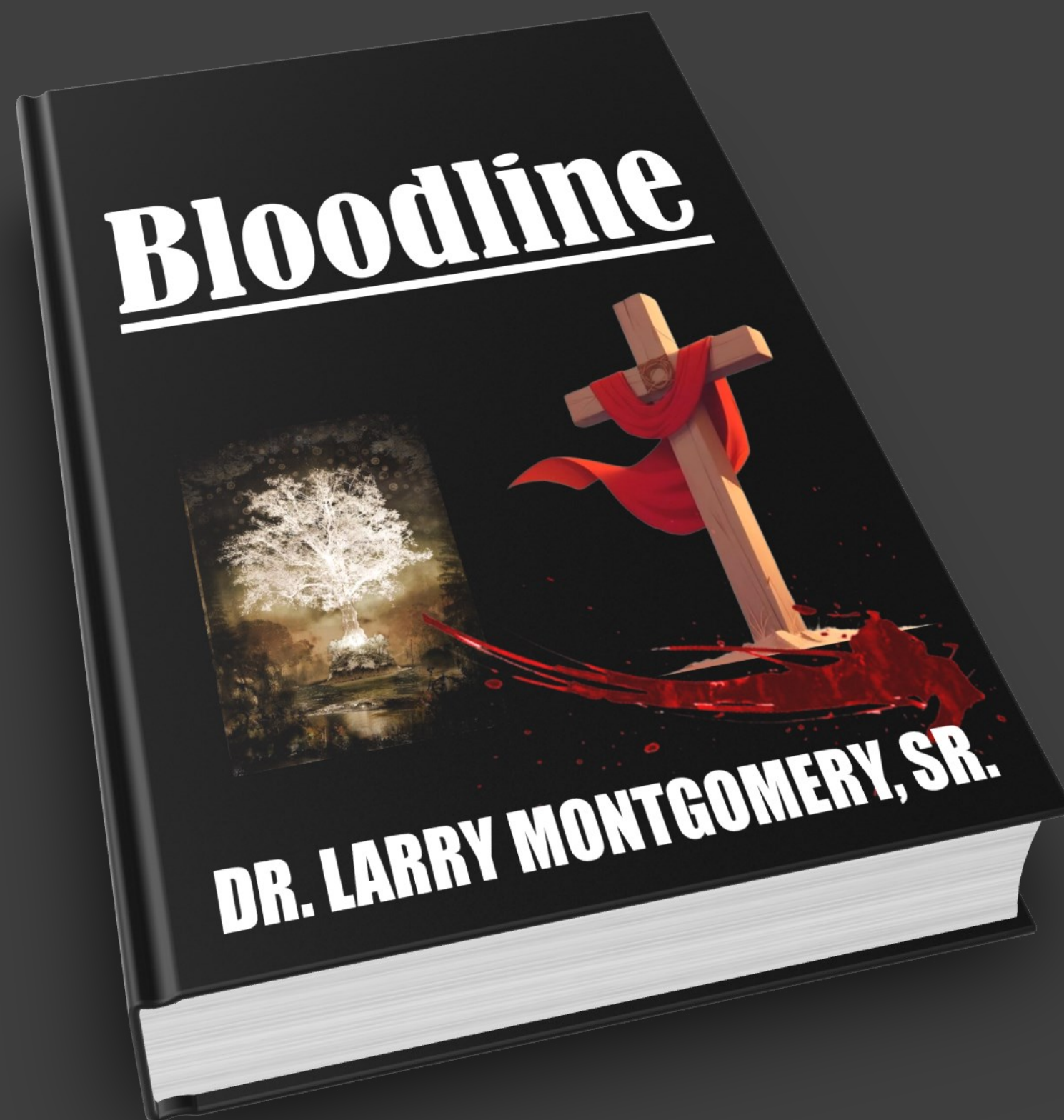




ABOUT THIS BOOK
