

## ABOUT THIS BOOK

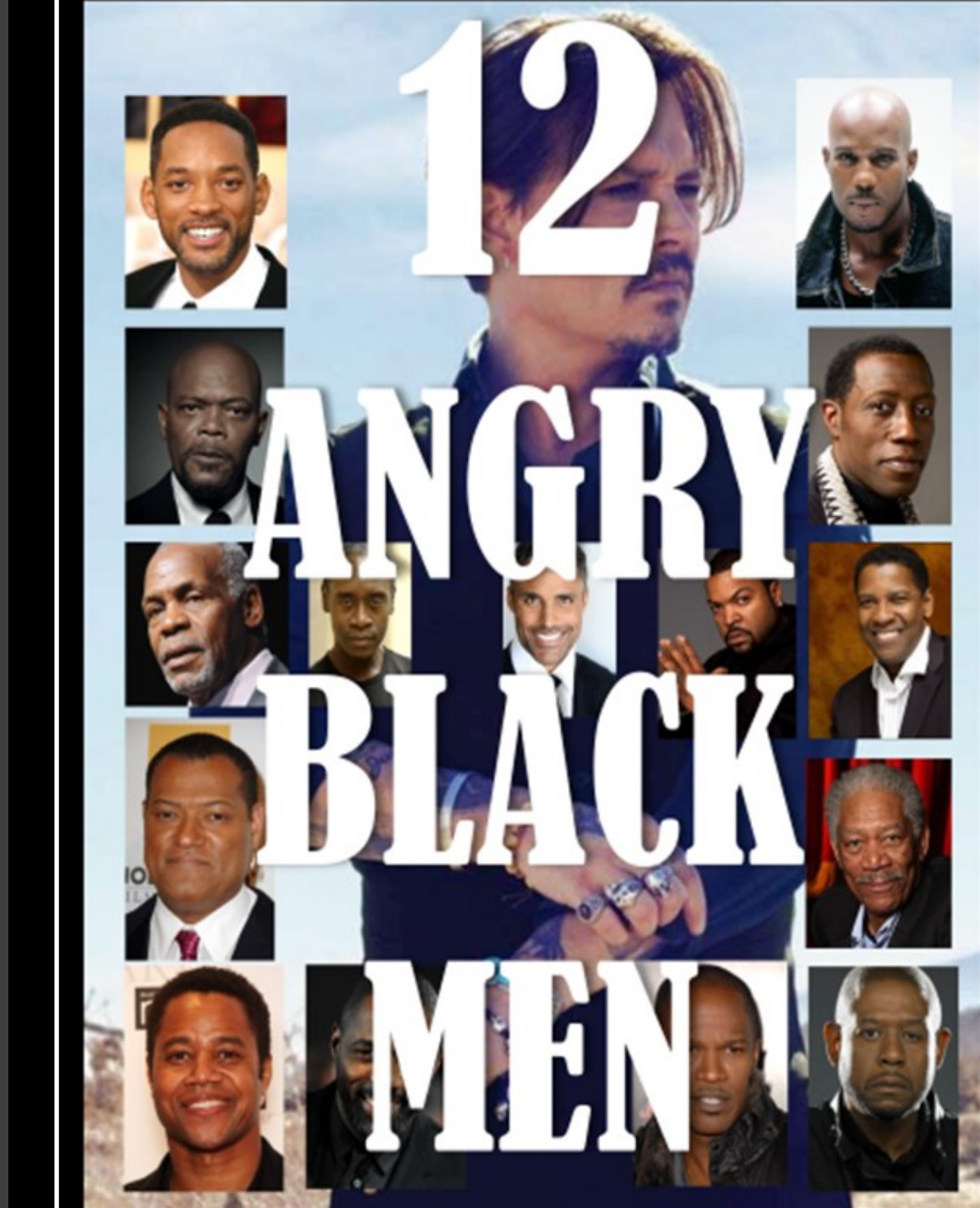
For the first time in history an all-Black male jury had been selected to render a life or death verdict on a white cop.
