

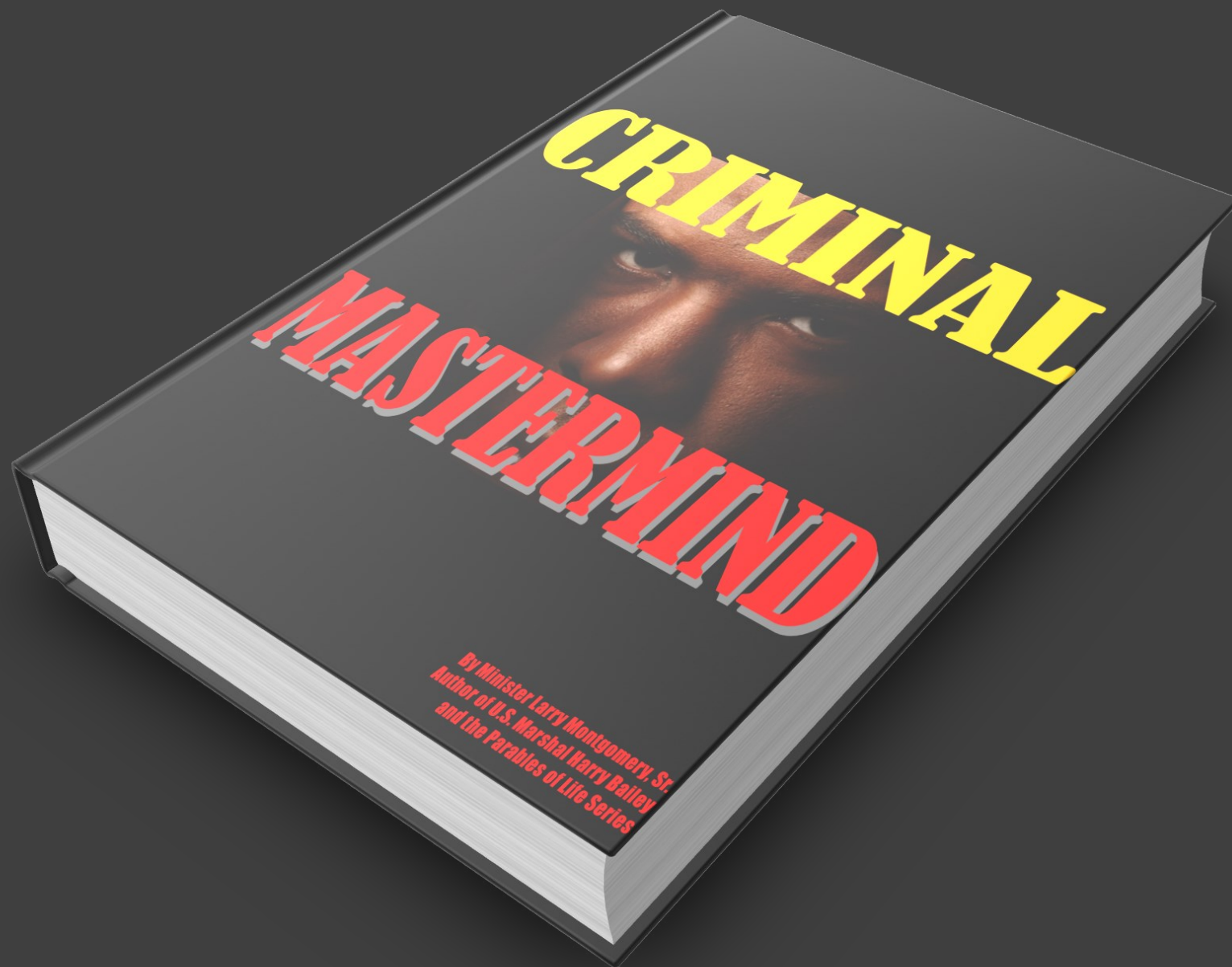
ABOUT THIS BOOK
