

ABOUT THIS BOOK

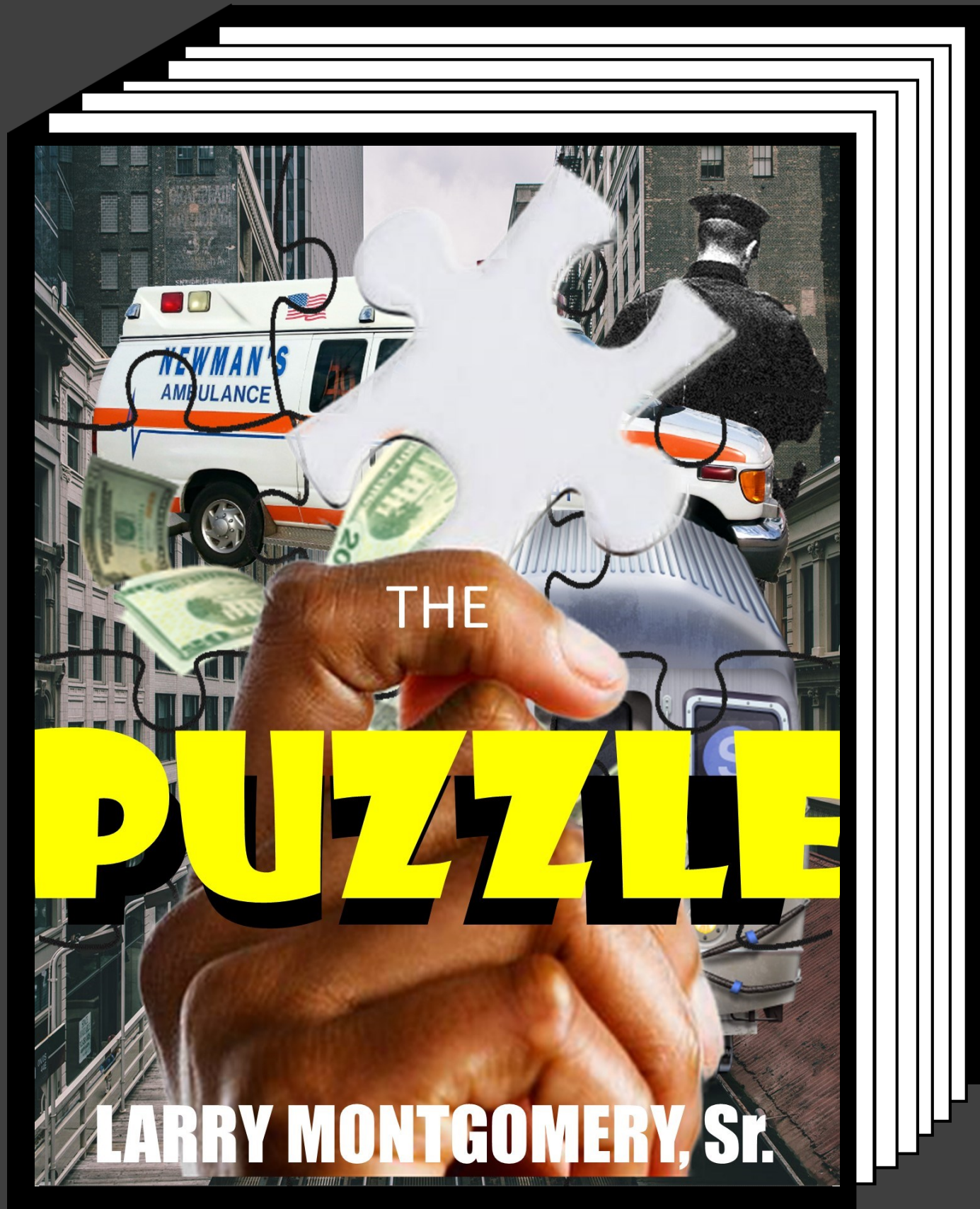
